DISTRIBUTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

During the present scare with Swine Flu and the restrictions we have had to impose on the serving of Holy communion, whilst we have prepared a new rota from 13th September, it will not be issued until the situation has been clarified.

In the meantime, Holy Communion will be served by two people, usually Clergy, or someone on the rota who is asked to help on the day. For anyone concerned, the wafers are handled only by those serving and only after they have cleaned their hands with an alcohol based, quick drying, anti-bacterial hand gel of the type used in hospitals.
