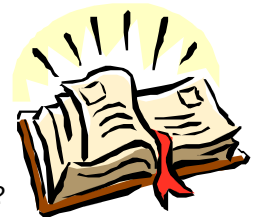

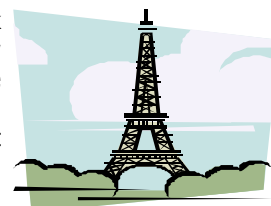
EVENTS COMING UP
