The course will start at 7pm on Friday 11th March when attendees can come to church and collect the ingredients for making what bakers call an overnight sponge. It takes two minutes to make a simple mix of ingredients that will ferment overnight.

At 9am on Saturday morning we will gather in the church centre and make the rest of the hot x buns. This will take just a couple of hours with lots of rest in between.
