- The references must not be from family or very close friends or current clergy. One could be your employer or an incumbent from a previous church, unless there are specific reasons why this is not appropriate in which case please indicate this.
- They must have known you for at least 2 years
- All references will be taken up.
- At least one referee should be able to comment on how you interact and work with the group your role is with (i.e. children / young people / adults).
